

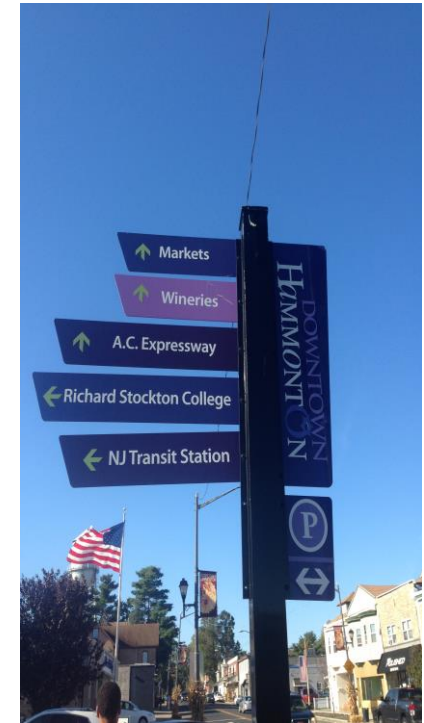
Convenience
